

To be effective in research activities development in the Baltic Sea region and beyond BMDA was creating a Strategic partnership with Emerald Group Publishing Limited (UK);


As a result of such strategic partnership the **Baltic Journal of Management (BJM)** was launched on **23rd March 2005.**




BMDA has created and is constantly developing the features students can benefit from:
